

Baseball Frequently Asked Questions

Where will games be played?

This year, games will be played in Celina, Gunter, and Pilot Point.

What will I need to buy after registration?

Your child will need a glove, cleats, orange socks, orange belt, and possibly a bat. Don't buy an expensive bat unless you love spoiling your child.

Are scholarships available?

Yes. However, scholarships are much more limited due to a lack of corporate sponsorships to offset costs.

When will I hear from my coach?

You should hear from your coach in the last few days of February.

When will practices begin?

Practices usually begin around the first week of March. Many coaches that coach baseball are also basketball coaches. They have to balance their baseball schedule with basketball.

When will games begin/end?

Games will begin around the 1st of April. Games will end around Memorial Day weekend. You will not play Easter weekend, but you will play games on Mother's Day weekend.

How many games will there be per week?

You can usually count on 2 games per week. Some of these games will be out-of-town on weeknights, so you need to be ready for that.

Will there be late games?

Yes, there will be "late" games. I've come to find out that some people have a much earlier idea of what "late" is. Games do not start until 6PM each day. Therefore, younger age groups (5/6) will start around that time. That means that some 8s will be starting a game at 8PM. Prepare for this.

Will there be All-Stars after the season?

For many age groups, yes! However, that does not mean that your child will be selected. Many times, these tournaments run during Father's Day weekend and/or July 4th Weekend. Plan accordingly.
